TOP NOTES

Brett Murray scored twice for his first multi-goal game of the season and first since April 3, 2021. He scored for the fourth time in five games. marking the best five-game stretch of his pro career. Three of his four five this season have come on the power-play, tying for most on the team and eighth in the AHL.

Linus Weissbach's fourth goal of the season extended his point streak to three straight games. The rookie forward shows one goal and two assists over that span and eight points overall (4+4) on the season.

Oskari Laaksonen has recorded eight points (1+7) over his last 10 games after picking up an assist on Murray's first-period goal. It was the secondyear defenseman's team-leading seventh power-play assist, which ranks second-most among all league defensemen behind only Scott Perunovich of the Springfield Thunderbirds.

He's now tied for fourth in assists and ranks 10th in scoring among all AHL blueliners.

Sean Malone notched his fifth point in seven games to begin the month of November with an assist on Rochester's first goal of the game. He also became the fourth Amerk this season to reach the 10-point mark.

JJ Peterka scored once in regulation and then netted the shootoutclinching goal in the third round.

Michael Houser made his first start of the season, stopping 28 of the 32 shots he faced for his first win. He's now 2-3-0 in five career starts.
