Linus Weissbach capped a three-goal, third-period comeback by scoring the game-winner with five seconds remaining in overtime. He also earned the lone assist on the game-tying goal by **Anders Bjork** with 3:15 remaining in regulation to record his fourth multipoint outing of the season.

**Brett Murray** scored twice in a span of 1:51 in the third period, including once on the power-play, tying him with Weissbach for the team's goal-scoring lead with seven.

It's was Murray's second multi-point outing in three games and his first multi-goal effort since Nov. 19 of last season when scored twice in a 5-4 win over the Lehigh Valley Phantoms.

With his two goals tonight, Murray is already within half of his career-high 15 goals he scored last season in only 16 games through the 2022-23 campaign.

**Michael Houser** made his second straight start and third in the last five games for Rochester. Its the first time he's made back-to-back starts since starting five straight games for the Amerks between Dec. 19 and Jan. 5 of last season.
