Sean Malone recorded a natural hat trick in the first period, scoring three times in a span of 5:07, and later added an assist for the first four-point night of his career. It was also the first trick of his career for Malone, who now has four goals in his last three games and 11 points (6+5) in nine games this season.

Brett Murray scored the game-winner 2:01 into overtime and added two assists for his third straight multi-point outing.

Linus Weissbach extended his scoring lead with an assist, giving him a team-high 14 points on the season (7+7).

Isak Rosen notched two assists, including the primary helper on Murray's overtime game-winner. Following tonight's performance, he's tied for fourth amongst all AHL rookies with a team-high 10 assists and tied for seventh in points (13).

Kale Clague scored his first goal as an Amerk tonight, his first in the AHL since March 26 during the shortened 2020-21 campaign.

Malcolm Subban earned his first win of the season and first since Dec. 21 of last season as a member of the Rockford IceHogs

With tonight's win, the Amerks improved to 7-1-1-0 on home ice, having earned points in eight of their first eight home contests so far this season. Five of Rochester's seven home victories have come when the team trailed entering the final period while all seven wins,, including tonight, have come by way of four or more goals.
