TOP NOTES

Following tonight's eight-goal effort, the Amerks have outscored the opposition 28-10 over their last four wins dating back to Feb. 24. It also marks back-to-back home games against Hartford where the Amerks have scored five goals or more, the last being Jan. 7, 2022.

By going 4-for-7 on the power-play tonight, the Amerks are 7-for-13 in their last four home games on the man-advantage.

Biro notched his team-leading 15th multi-point effort of the season with one goal and four assists, representing the first five-point effort of his career. The third-year pro now has 45 points in 44 games in 2022-23 and 91 points in 107 career games with the Amerks.

Lukas Rousek (2+1) recorded the first multi-goal game of his career as part of a three-point performance, giving him 13 points (3+10) in his last 10 games dating back to Feb. 24.

Jeremy Davies scored for the second time in three games, giving him 10 goals on the season for the first time in his pro career. He also becomes the first Amerks defensemen to reach the 10-goal mark.

Ethan Prow finished with four points (1+3), all of which came on the power-play. After tonight, he ranks 12th amongst all AHL defensemen in assists (27) and 13th in points (33). Prow has also reached the 30-point mark in each of his last four AHL seasons.

Newcomer **Austin Strand** recorded his first point as an Amerk in his Rochester debut with an assist on Davies' first-period goal.
