TOP NOTES

Tonight's win forces a decisive Game 5 in Syracuse on Saturday, May 6. All four games in the series have been won by the home team.

Jiri Kulich scored for the second straight game on the power-play and added an assist for his first multi-point game of the playoffs. After tonight, he's now tied for fifth in postseason scoring amongst all AHL rookies.

With Kulich's goal, the Amerks have gone 4-for-10 on the power-play over the last two games of the series, which includes scoring three times on four chances in Game 3.

Rochester has the third-best power-play unit at home in the playoffs with a 40.0% conversion rate.

Malcolm Subban stopped all 31 shots he faced, including 12 in the third period, to pick up his first career AHL playoff shutout and third overall on the season.

Subban is the first Amerks netminder to post a shutout in the postseason since Ryan Miller in Game 1 of Rochester's first-round series against Hamilton on May 5, 2004.

With his third-period goal, Lawrence Pilut has three points (1+2) in four playoff contests, tying him for 11th amongst all AHL defensemen.

The Amerks have outscored Syracuse 8-4 in the third period throughout the series.
