TOP NOTES

After dropping their first two games of the 2023 Calder Cup Playoffs, the Amerks have now won seven consecutive games, marking the team's longest playoff win streak since 1996 when Rochester won nine straight.

Tonight's win improved the Amerks to 6-2 all-time in the opening game of a playoff series against Hershey dating back to Game 1 of the 1965 Calder Cup Finals. Rochester would go on to win its first of six Calder Cups.

Over their current seven-game win streak, the Amerks have outscored the opposition 41-21, including 12-3 in the first period over that span.

Despite seeing his AHL-best six-game goal-scoring streak come to an end, **Jiri Kulich** recorded an assist on Rochester's third goal of the game, giving the rookie forward at least one point in all seven playoff games he's appeared in, marking the longest active point streak in the postseason.

Mason Jobst also extended his point streak to seven games with his third goal of the postseason. He now leads the Amerks with 12 points (3+9) in nine playoff contests.

Led by **Jeremy Davies'** two-assist effort, a defenseman recorded a point on all five Amerks goals.

Brett Murray factored in on both first-period goals, recording the primary assist on **Joseph Cecconi's** goal 14 seconds into the contest before scoring his fourth of the postseason. The fourth-year pro has points in each of his last four games, including goals in three. He's totaled 16 points (9+7) in 19 career playoff games with Rochester.

With his second-period goal tonight, **Matt Bartkowski** has goals in back-to-back games for the first time in his AHL career.

Malcolm Subban, who has started all nine playoff games so far, made 21 saves to pick up his seventh straight win of the postseason. It matches his longest win streak of the regular season when he won seven straight from Dec. 10 to Jan. 11.

Ethan Prow extended his assist streak to an AHL-best six straight games. It also ties the second-longest point streak by a defenseman in the postseason. **Lawrence Pilut** also had a six-game point streak from April 28 to May 17, totaling eight points (3+5) over that span.
