TOP NOTES & STORYLINES

The Amerks improved to 6-2 in their last eight games when facing eliminiation since the start of the 2023 Calder Cup Playoffs and 34-43 all-time. Including tonight, Rochester has won its last five road elimination games, picking up victories at Laval (2025), Syracuse (in 2023 and 2024), at Hershey (2023) and at Utica (2022).

Josh Dunne factored in on each of Rochester's first four goals of the night, scoring the game's first and fourth goals in addition to recording the primary assist on goals from Tyson Kozak and Isak Rosén in the first and second periods, respectively.

It's the first career four-point effort for **Dunne** and his first multi-point playoff game since scoring twice for Cleveland in Game 5 of last year's Eastern Conference Finals against Hershey. He's also the first Amerk to record four points in a playoff game since **Lukáš Rousek** in Game 3 of the North Division Finals on May 17, 2023.

Dunne has produced 18 points (10+8) in 21 career Calder Cup Playoff appearances, including seven points (3+4) in seven games with Rochester this spring.

Lukáš Rousek notched two assists, with both coming on the powerplay. **Rousek** has recorded a point in each of the last three games of the series for the Amerks and has points in six of his last seven games overall dating back to Rochester's regular-season finale, totaling three goals and seven assists for 10 points over that span.

After being held without a point for the first time this postseason in Game 3 on Wednesday, **Kale Clague** found his way back to the scoresheet by assisting on both goals from Dunne, the first of which came on the power-play. It marks his third multi-point effort of the series and fourth overall of the postseason. **Clague's** team-high 11 points (5+6) continue to lead all AHL defensemen and are tied for third-most among all top point-getters.

Isak Rosén scored his fourth goal of the series on the power-play. Up until tonight, each of **Rosén's** previous four goals in the Calder Cup Playoffs were scored on home ice.

Tyson Kozak recorded two points (1+1) and **Devon Levi** improved to 5-2 in the postseason on the strength of a 22-save performance.
