TOP NOTES & STORYLINES

Konsta Helenius factored in on all four goals, scoring twice and adding two assists for his first four-point game as an Amerk. The multi-goal outing is **Helenius'** first since getting a hat trick against Belleville last season on April 5, 2025. When **Helenius** registers multiple points in a game, the Amerks are 7-0-1-0.

Devon Levi posted 19 saves for his first shutout of the season and first of his career against Laval. The 23-year-old yields eight career shutouts as an Amerk after recording seven last season, becoming the first Amerks goaltender with more than six shutouts in a single season since **Ryan Miller** (2004-05).

Two nights after **Brendan Warren** appeared in his 200th game as an Amerk, **Isak Rosén** did the same, becoming the 64th forward in franchise history to do so. The fourth-year pro recorded two points, giving him at least one point in all but one game so far, and continues to lead the team with nine points (4+5). **Rosén** trails only Wilkes-Barre/Scranton's Danton Heinen for the AHL scoring lead.

Jagger Joshua scored for the second straight game, giving him goals in back-to-back games for the first time since Feb. 17 and 21, 2024.

Zac Jones continued his point-per-game pace start to the season, assisting on three of Rochester's four goals for his third multi-assist performance.

Jones, who's only been held scoreless twice through his first six games, leads all AHL defensemen in points (8) and power-play assists (7) while ranking second in shots (21). With eight points through his first six games, it marks **Jones's** best start to a season since entering the league ahead of the 2021-22 campaign with Hartford.

Thanks to **Helenius's** second goal of the game, the Amerks have scored on the power-play in five of their first six games so far this season. Rochester leads the AHL with nine power-play goals and has the second-best power-play in the league with a 34.6% conversion rate, trailing only Milwaukee.

Rochester is now 3-0-0-0 on home ice. The last time the Amerks won their first three home games of the season was in 2022-23 when the team opened the season with five straight home wins.
