### **TOP NOTES & STORYLINES**

**Carson Meyer** made his Amerks and 2025-26 season debut, scoring his first of the season to get Rochester on the board to spark a fourgoal third period **Meyer** appeared in his first game since Feb. 15, when he suffered a season-ending injury with the San Diego Gulls. In 202 AHL games, the sixth-year pro has amassed 66 goals and assists for 132 points across Rochester, San Diego, and Cleveland.

Meyer's goal began a run of three goals scored within a 2:20 span. Joining in next was **Anton Wahlberg**, scoring his third goal of the season and second of the year against Belleville. **Wahlberg** has three points (1+2) over his last three games.

**Riley Fiddler-Schultz** completed the stretch with his second goal of the season and fourth of his career against the Senators. The goal ended an 11-game drought for the second-year Amerk.

**Jake Leschyshyn** continued his stretch, leading the Amerks in goalscoring with his seventh of the season. The veteran has posted four goals over his last four games. **Leschyshyn** is one of eight forwards in the Eastern Conference with at least seven goals.

**Ryan Johnson** notched a pair of assists, bringing his season total to six which tops all active Amerk defensemen with **Zac Jones** currently on recall to the Buffalo Sabres. The pair of points marks **Johnson**'s third multi-point game of the season.

**Trevor Kuntar** posted the lone multi-point game from an Amerks forward, threading two assists to increase his season total to eight points (5+3). The third-year pro extended his point streak to three games, reaching three goals and five points over that span. The streak of three marks a new career high for **Kuntar**.

**Topias Leinonen** appeared in relief of **Devon Levi**, marking his first career game in Rochester. The 21-year-old has made three starts for Rochester, with each coming on the road. **Leinonen** was not required to make a save, facing zero shots. The Sabres' prospect is 1-2-0 on the season.

**Brendan Warren** skated in his 300th professional game. The sixthyear Amerk has played 209 of his contests with Rochester.
