The quest to the Calder Cup continues tonight as the Amerks, fresh off a second-round sweep of the Syracuse Crunch, host the regular-season champion Laval Rocket in Game 1 of the North Division Finals at Blue Cross Arena. It's the first postseason meeting between the two teams since the Rocket swept Rochester in the same round just three years prior.

STAR PLAYERS

Jacob Fowler has made an immediate impact with the Rocket since signing his entry-level contract with Montreal last month. Fowler, who was named the Hockey East Goaltender of the Year for the second straight season in 2024-25, is 3-0 through his first three playoff starts, boasting a 1.00 goals-against average and a .953 save percentage with one shutout. He ranks second behind Levi in all goaltending categories.

Devon Levi carried over his year-end dominance into the postseason, posting back-to-back 4-0 shutouts in the series win over Syracuse. Levi is only the third goaltender in Amerks franchise history to record consecutive playoff shutouts and the first since Mika Noronen did it twice in 2000. Levi has stopped 90 of the 92 shots he faced and hasn't allowed a goal in 156:31 of game action since Game 1 of the North Division Semifinals.

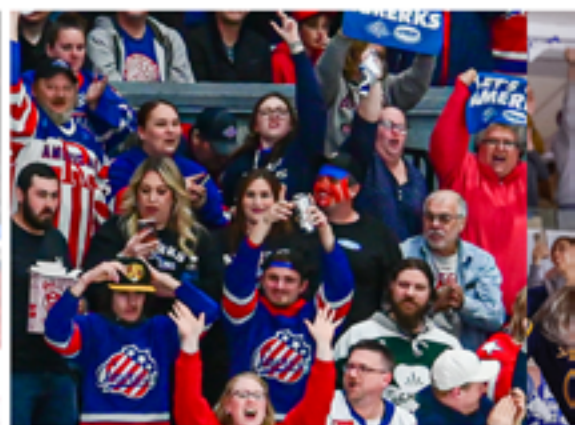
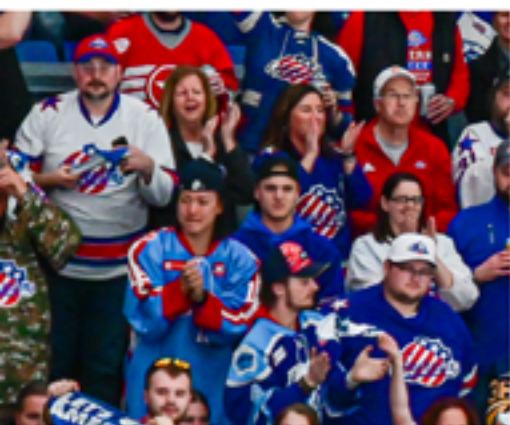

THE BEGINNINGS

Embarking on its **89th season** in 2024-25, the American Hockey League is continuing a tradition of excellence that began in 1936 when the Canadian-American Hockey League joined with the International Hockey League to form what is today known as the AHL. Eight teams hit the ice that first season, representing Buffalo, Cleveland, New Haven, Philadelphia, Pittsburgh, Providence, Springfield and Syracuse.

Frank Calder, the National Hockey League's president at the time, was instrumental in the forming of this new league, and his name would be given to its championship trophy. **The first Calder**

Cup was won by the Syracuse Stars in 1937; the Hershey Bears captured their league-best 13th championship last spring.

From those roots, the American Hockey League has grown into a 32-team, coast-to-coast league that provides fans with exciting, high-level professional hockey while preparing thousands of players, coaches, officials, executives, trainers, broadcasters and more for careers in the NHL.



▶ THE PLAYERS

In today's National Hockey League nearly 90 percent of the players are AHL alumni,

including 2023-24 Vezina Trophy winner **Connor Hellebuyck**, Lady Byng Trophy recipient **Jacob Slavin** and Bill Masterton Trophy winner **Connor Ingram**. The 2024 Stanley Cup champion Florida Panthers were stocked with AHL graduates including former league scoring champion **Carter Verhaeghe** and two-time AHL All-Star **Brandon Montour**.

During the 2023-24 season, a total of **890 AHL alumni** played in the National Hockey League. There were **349 players** who skated in both leagues last year alone, and **251 former first- and second-round NHL draft picks** developed their skills in the AHL last season, including **Shane Wright**, **David Jiricek**, **Jiri Kulich**, **Lukas Reichel**, **Marco Kasper**, **Brad Lambert**, **Yaroslav Askarov**, **Brandt Clarke** and 2024 Calder Cup Playoffs MVP **Hendrix Lapierre**.

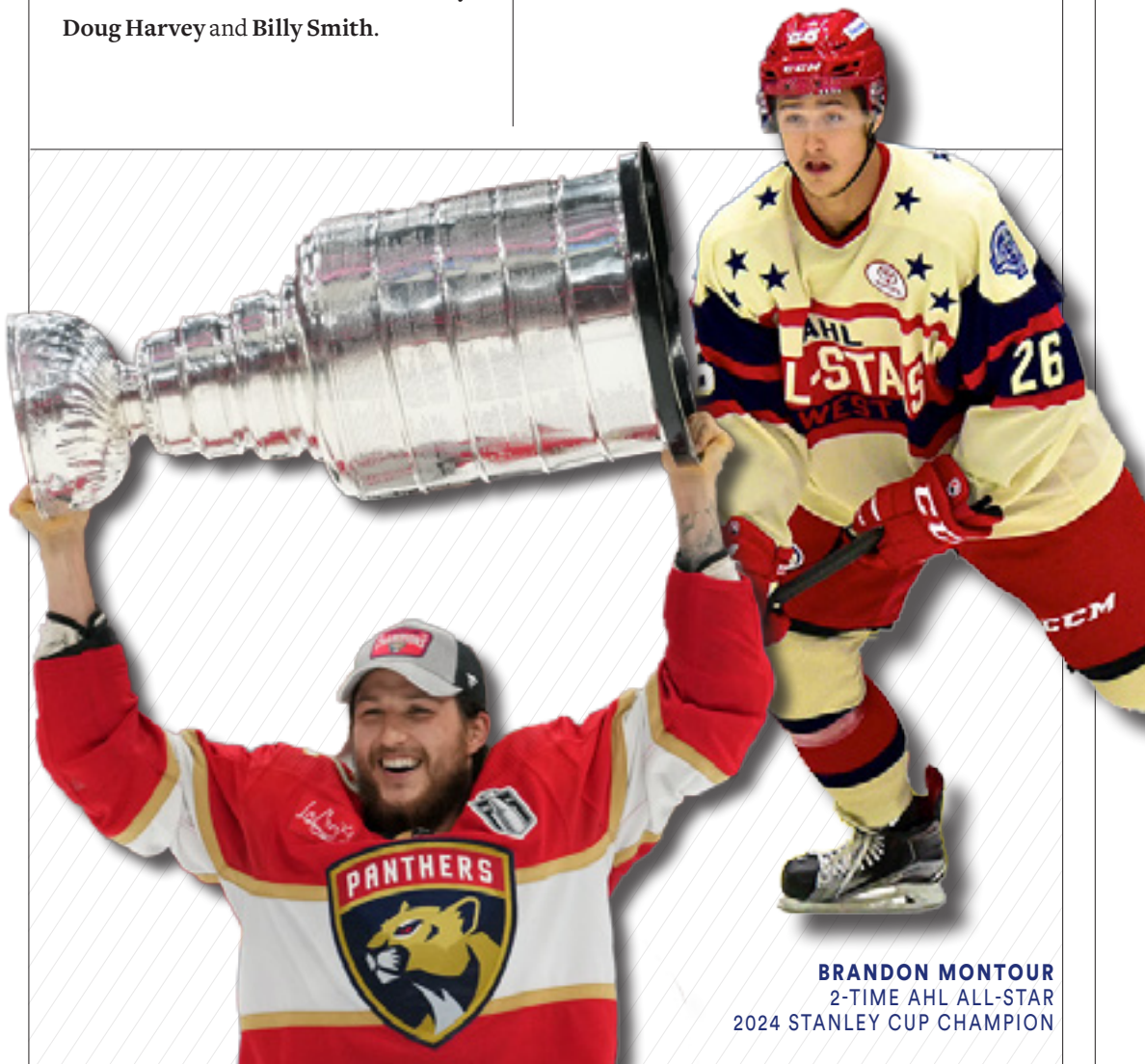
▶ THE LEGENDS

For nearly nine decades, the American Hockey League has been home to some of the greatest players in the history of our sport. In fact, **there are 133 honored members of the Hockey Hall of Fame who have been affiliated with the AHL during their careers.** All-time greats from **Milt Schmidt** and **Gump Worsley** to **Roberto Luongo** and **Martin St. Louis** came through the AHL ranks and now find themselves enshrined in Toronto, and the coveted Calder Cup is inscribed with the names of legendary AHL alumni like **Johnny Bower**, **Larry Robinson**, **Gerry Cheevers**, **Andy Bathgate**, **Tim Horton**, **Al Arbour**, **Emile Francis**, **Patrick Roy**, **Doug Harvey** and **Billy Smith**.

▶ THE COACHES

At the start of the 2024-25 season, the National Hockey League featured **22 head coaches who were former AHL bench bosses**, including **Paul Maurice** of the 2024 Stanley Cup champion Florida Panthers and **Kris Knoblauch** of the Western Conference champion Edmonton Oilers.

Tampa Bay's **Jon Cooper**, New Jersey's **Sheldon Keefe**, San Jose's **Ryan Warsofsky**, Colorado's **Jared Bednar**, Washington's **Spencer Carbery** and Seattle's **Dan Bylsma** are also among the current NHL coaches who spent time in the American Hockey League before making the jump.
