


# Current and Former Amerks (by last name)



## Across

- 4 Nicknamed "Grapes." One of the most iconic defensemen in Amerks franchise history.
- 6 Former team captain and newest member of the Amerks Hall of Fame.
- 9 Current Amerks defenseman who last season set the single-season franchise record for goals by a defenseman.
- 11 Captained the Amerks to the 1983 Calder Cup championship.
- 13 Amerks Hall of Fame who was part of the 1983 Calder Cup-winning team.
- 17 Another physical defenseman who helped the Amerks win the Calder Cup in 1996. Currently an assistant coach with the Detroit Red Wings.
- 18 Set the single-season franchise record with 446 penalty minutes as a rookie during the 1988-89 season. Current color commentator for all Sabres broadcasts.
- 19 Nicknamed "Red" for his hair. Revolutionized the defenseman position. His No. 6 was the first to be retired by the organization.
- 21 Abbreviation for referee's call when a goal is waved off.
- 23 Scored 30 goals last season for Rochester. Currently one of the top scoring NHL rookies.
- 24 Hard-nosed defenseman and former captain known for his vicious hip checks.
- 26 Amerks Hall of Famer and fan favorite who racked up the most penalty minutes in franchise history.
- 30 Amerks Hall of Famer who played five seasons on Rochester's blueline.
- 32 Current Amerks captain.
- 33 Captain of the 1996 Calder Cup-winning team.
- 34 Two-time MVP goaltender who's currently with the Buffalo Sabres.
- 35 Joined the Amerks in December after spending all last season with Buffalo.
- 38 Fiery former head coach who led the team to the Calder Cup in 1983.
- 39 Currently leads the Amerks in scoring with 39 points in 57 games.
- 40 Amerks Hall of Famer who began and ended his career in Rochester.
- 41 Former head coach known as "Boxie"

## Down

- 1 Legendary head coach who led the Amerks to three Calder Cups in a four-year span in the 60s.
- 2 Former goaltender played four seasons with the Amerks before graduating to the NHL permanently. Amerks Hall of Famer.
- 3 Former goaltender holds the franchise record for the most shutouts in a season (8).
- 5 High-scoring forward led the Amerks with 37 goals during the team's inaugural campaign.
- 7 Spent time in Rochester as a both a player and a coach. The all-time winningest head coach in franchise history.
- 8 Rochester native who played parts of five seasons with the Amerks and totaled 287 NHL games.
- 10 Legenday Amerks defenseman who went onto win several Stanley Cups as head coach of the NY Islanders.
- 11 Joined the Amerks in 1963 and remained until 1970, winning three Calder Cups along the way.
- 12 Goaltender who made his NHL debut with the Sabres this season.
- 14 Played seven seasons with the Amerks, leading the team to its first three Calder Cups.
- 15 Goaltender known as "The Hamburglar".
- 16 Amerks Hall of Famer who was a key member of the 1987 Calder Cup-winning team.
- 20 Highest scoring defenseman in franchise history.
- 22 The original No. 9 who served as player, coach and GM. Led the team to three Calder Cups in four years. His jersey hangs in the rafters.
- 25 Became hockey's first goalie to score a goal by shooting it the length of the ice.
- 27 Fan favorite known as "Sharky" during his time with the Amerks. Help Rochester win the 1996 Calder Cup.
- 28 Came out of retirement for three more seasons with the Amerks. Won the Calder Cup in 1996.
- 29 Fan favorite who spent his entire 10-year career in the Buffalo Sabres organization.
- 31 In his second season in Rochester. Made his NHL debut this season with Buffalo.
- 32 Two-time Calder Cup winner who's currently in his seventh season with the Amerks.
- 36 Amerks Hall of Famer who spent nine seasons as player in Rochester and now serves as head

coach.

**37** AHL Hall of Famer and franchise's all-time leader in goals, assists, points and games played.
